

7th Annual Idea Leap Grant

You're invited to TVFCU's biggest Idea Leap Grant ever!

For the second time ever, TVFCU is hosting multiple Idea Leap Grant Pitch Competition Events, one each in the Chattanooga, Ocoee, and Northwest Georgia areas. We are giving away a grand total of \$225,000 to entrepreneurs this year, exceeding last year's total of \$175,000. This initiative supports the small business ecosystem within TVFCU's 17-county service area. Entrepreneurs will pitch their business ideas to a panel of judges.

The Idea Leap Grant events align with National Small Business Week, in May. We'll kickoff the week on April 29 in Calhoun, GA with the Northwest Georgia area reception and pitch competition beginning at 6 p.m. The Gordon County Chamber Reception will host the reception beginning at 5 p.m. Both the reception and the pitch competition will be held at Harris Arts Center - 212 S. Wall St.

The Ocoee Region Idea Leap Reception and Pitch competition will be held April 30. The Cleveland/Bradley Chamber of Commerce are the reception sponsors. The reception will begin at 5 p.m., followed by the Cleveland Area Pitch Competition at 6 p.m. Both events will take place at the PIE Center, located at 2337 Parker St NE.

In Chattanooga, the public is invited to attend two different Idea Leap events on May 2.



The Idea Leap Luncheon and the Reception / Pitch Competition will be held at The Signal located at 21 Choo Choo Avenue. The Idea Leap Luncheon will be from 11:30 a.m.- 1 p.m. with guest speaker Karen Hutton.

The Chambliss Startup Group will host the reception which begins at 4:30 p.m., followed by the pitch competition.
